Activities, species and locations covered by this licence are listed in Annex 1		

Conditions	
1	Subject to any modification(s) required by this licence, the holder or any agent is only permitted to take or kill the species listed in Annex 1 using the means and methods described in General Licences 01-03/2016 and only in the manner prescribed by those licences.
2	Carrion crow, magpie and greater black-backed gull may only be taken or killed until the 30th June 2016.
3	Rook, jackdaw and woodpigeon may only be taken or killed until the 31st of August 2016.
4	While engaged in work authorised by this licence, the licence holder and agents must each be able to produce a copy of this licence to any Police Officer or official of SNH on demand.
5	That prior to exercising this licence SNH licensing (licensing@snh.gov.uk or 01463725364) must be provided with details of the number, type and locations of deployment (to 6-figure grid-reference) of all traps proposed to be used under this licence. If traps are to be moved then details of proposed locations must be provided prior to deployment in a new area.
6	A log must be kept and submitted to SNH within 1 month of the expiry of this licence detailing all work carried out under this licence. This must include a record of what species have been controlled or taken, where, when and in what number and by what means.
Notes	
Licence holders or any other persons covered by this licence should note the following;	
1	This licence is granted subject to compliance with the conditions as specified. Anything done otherwise than in accordance with the terms of the licence may constitute an offence.
2	Agents may work independently of the licence holder. It is the responsibility of the licence holder to ensure that agents have the appropriate training and experience and that they understand the terms and conditions of this licence.
3	Nothing in this licence shall confer any right of entry on to land or property.
4	This licence may be modified or revoked at any time by SNH.
5	This licence only exempts any legal provision contained in the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended).
6	SNH reserve the right to inspect traps or to accompany anyone covered by this licence whilst carrying out work permitted by it.
