I have been forwarded your contact details via your colleague [REDACTED].

I am looking to submit an application to NRW for the reintroduction of Golden eagles back into Snowdonia. I will do this under the banner of [REDACTED]. To prevent confusions, mixed messaging and wasted time and resources for all parties, I feel it would be very constructive to meet at the earliest opportunity to discuss plans and expectations for any application.

A quick overview of where the project is, is as follows. [REDACTED] have now completed a national habitat feasibility study for Golden eagles in Wales and this will be published in due course (hopefully soon). The result are clear in that Snowdonia comes out as by far the most promising site in Wales (although much of Wales is suitable). Indeed it is likely far better than many places that eagles are currently found in Scotland. We are currently modelling this. You will of course be aware of the history of golden eagles and their association with Snowdonia so there are strong ecological and cultural reasons that stand out for Snowdonia to be selected as the first site. It will also be obvious that there are considerable ecotourism and job creation opportunities as well as the Golden eagle being the ideal flagship species for large scale upland restoration.
