The main document I will send over is the feasibility map and a brief report justifying methods and key findings.

I will also send over an overview of our consultation plans.

The application is currently being drafted and completed as much as is possible prior to input from NRW.

Background, species ecology, previous distribution etc is all in there but that's all pretty standard stuff taken the existing body of scientific literature.

In terms of methodology, again this is all very standard stuff and there have been multiple eagle releases that have all followed the same tried and tested 'hacking' methodology. Our plans will be no different and will of course reference the other projects. I was lucky enough to spend 3 days with the Director of the Irish Golden eagle project and visited the first release sites, holding cages etc in Ireland. The way they successfully did it in Glenveagh National Park was wonderfully simple, low tech and effective. We hope to emulate their approach and success.

The Ecologist [REDACTED] is away til midweek but then I will ask him to get the feasibility material together and get it to you next week.
